<b>4. SQAR Detail Description</b>	
<p>The Supplier shall provide traceability of all materials utilized to manufacture or assemble the items covered by the Purchase Order. These parts are typically controlled by lot numbers (not serial numbers; serial number traceability is captured in SQAR-24). The Traceability Summary must contain the following at a minimum:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>a. Part Number</li><li>b. Part Description</li><li>c. b. Revision Level</li><li>d. c. Supplier Name (include CFM)</li><li>e. Lot or Batch Number, if applicable</li><li>f. Expiration Date, if applicable</li></ol>	
<b>5. Disclaimer</b>	
<p>The following Supplemental Quality Assurance Requirement (SQAR) clause is a requirement when specified by number within the Request for Quote (RFQ), Purchase Order (PO), or Quality Assurance Document (QAD). In the event of conflict between the General Supplier Quality Assurance Requirements document, PAL 164, and a SQAR flowdown, the SQAR will always supersede. Flowdown of this SQAR to sub-tier suppliers is required to ensure final product compliance.</p>
