

1.0 Requirements:

The Supplier shall maintain a Quality Management System (QMS) The Supplier's QMS shall be subject to review and/or audit by the GD-OTS Buyer or other designated representative. No waiver or deviation from the QMS requirements shall be permitted without written approval from the GD-OTS Buyer.

QCSD-002A - The supplier's QMS shall be approved by GD-OTS prior to contract performance.

QCSD-002B - The supplier's QMS shall comply with the requirements of ISO 9001, with no relevant exclusions (at a minimum).

QCSD-002C - The supplier's QMS shall comply with the requirements of AS9100, with no relevant exclusions (at a minimum).

For ISO 9001 and AS9100 QMS's, the Supplier must provide adequate evidence that the Quality Management System has been successfully audited by a third party register. A copy of the third party certificate shall be forwarded to the GD-OTS Buyer. In the event that the Supplier's QMS loses certification, the Supplier must notify the GD-OTS Buyer within 24 hours in writing of the Supplier's plan to attain recertification.

Compliance with ISO 9001 or AS9100 supersedes the need for GD-OTS approval of the Supplier's QMS (unless otherwise noted in the Purchase Order), however GD-OTS reserves the right to review/audit the QMS.
