Objective evidence means documentation indicating that the materials supplied were melted in the United States, its outlying areas, or a qualifying country.</p> <p><i>Note: See DFARS 225.252-7008, 225.252-7009 and 7010 for definitions of Certain Articles Containing Specialty Metals</i></p>	
<b>5. Disclaimer</b>	
The following Supplemental Quality Assurance Requirement (SQAR) clause is a requirement when specified by number within the Request for Quote (RFQ), Purchase Order (PO), or Quality Assurance Document (QAD). In the event of conflict between the General Supplier Quality Assurance Requirements document and a SQAR flowdown, the SQAR will always supersede. Flowdown of this SQAR to sub-tier suppliers is required to ensure final product compliance.
