<p>A. If goods are standard hardware supplier must include the original manufacturer's certifications, with each shipment.</p> <p>B. If products appear on the Qualified Products Listing (QPL), the certification must contain documentation of manufacture by QPL's approved source, including the manufacturer's QPL designation.</p> <p>C. If subcontractor is required to use customer approved special process sources, the Certification must contain documentation of manufacture by all approved sources.</p> <p>D. If an item on the Purchase Order invokes by reference a military specification, military standards or other revision-controlled requirements document, the revisions in effect are as of the date of the Purchase Order, unless otherwise specified.</p> <p>E. If required by Purchase Order, the Supplier, at a minimum, must sample, test or inspect a sample, part or coupon. This sample, test or inspection shall be performed at the time of the First Article and at least once each 12-month period thereafter to ensure Sub-tier Supplier compliance.</p>

The following Supplemental Quality Assurance Requirement (SQAR) clause is a requirement when specified by number within the Request for Quote (RFQ), Purchase Order (PO), or Quality Assurance Document (QAD). In the event of conflict between the General Supplier Quality Assurance Requirements document and a SQAR flowdown, the SQAR will always supersede. Flowdown of this SQAR to sub-tier suppliers is required to ensure final product compliance.
